

# Hand Sanitizers

Using a hand sanitizer helps prevent germs from spreading.

**Rub hands for hand hygiene! Wash hands when visibly soiled.**

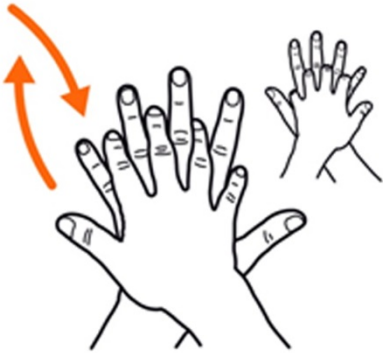
Duration of the entire procedure is **20-30 seconds**.



**1** Apply a palmful of the product in a cupped hand, covering all surfaces



**2** Rub hands palm to palm



**3** Right palm over back of left hand with interlaced fingers and vice versa



**4** Palm to palm with fingers interlaced



**5** Backs of fingers to opposing palms with fingers interlocked



**6** Rotational rubbing of left thumb clasped in right palm and vice versa



**7** Rotational rubbing, backwards and forwards with clasped fingers of right hand in left palm and vice versa



**8** Once dry, your hands are safe
